BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

The El Dorado County Water Agency ("Agency") has a program in place where funding is made available to local water purveyors for projects that help to improve water supply reliability and water quality. This is a cost share grant program where the Agency and District share a 50% match of the cost.

District staff met with representatives from the Agency and identified three project needs. These are summarized as assistance with the cost of Construction Management for the Auburn Lake Trails Project ("ALT") (Agency contribution of \$50,000), Coating for the water storage tank at Walton (Agency contribution of \$5,500), and Consultant services for the development of a system master plan and 5-year CIP (Agency contribution of \$15,000). The summation of the three projects will result in grant funding in the amount of \$75,500. The specifics of the three projects are further identified in the attached table as provided by the Agency.

These three projects were approved for funding at a regular meeting of the Agency held on December 14, 2016. The Interim General Manager of the Agency was authorized to enter into a funding agreement with the District for a not-to-exceed cost share amount of \$75,500. Matching funds for the District, in the amount of \$75,500, are identified within the current FY 2016-17 Capital Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Interim General Manager to enter into a cost share funding agreement with the El Dorado County Water Agency for the ALT Project, the Water Storage Tank Project at Walton and the development of a Master Plan and 5-year CIP.
