BACKGROUND

The Walton Lake Water Treatment Plant (Walton WTP) produces treated water for distribution within the District. The Walton WTP Filter #3 is showing signs that it needs to be rebuilt.

The filter was originally installed in 1980. Some repairs to the filter are believed to have been completed in past years, but no record of these repairs is available. According to District staff, the filter media was replaced in the late 1990's and all PVC underdrain laterals were replaced. It is also believed that the filter was rebuilt in 2004, which included media replacement, recoating of the filter tank interior, and replacement of the surface wash system. No significant repairs to the filter have been made since the 2004. Filters are a critical component of the treatment process and failure can lead to the inability to produce water suitable for consumption.

The Walton Lake WTP Filter #3 Rehabilitation Project will involve emptying and cleaning the existing filter, repair of broken piping, and replacement of the filter media. Additional work is expected to include repair to the piping connections and repairs to cracked bulkheads.

Completion of this Project supports Fiscal Year 2019/2020 Board of Directors Goal B – "Address Immediate Infrastructure Needs and Begin Long Term Planning," Objective B-1 – "Repair/Replace a few key facilities that are prone to failure".

The project information sheet from the Capital Improvement Plan is included as **Attachment 1.**

Walton Lake Water Treatment Plant Filter #3 Rehabilitation Project Board Meeting of September 8, 2020 Agenda Item No. 8.H.

On February 11, 2020, the Board approved a professional services agreement with Coastland Civil Engineering to provide project management services to the District for various capital projects and the task order was executed on February 27, 2020.

DISCUSSION

On June 10, 2020, the District released a request for bids for the project. Three (3) potential bidders attended the non-mandatory pre-bid meeting on June 18, 2020 and made a visit to the project location.

The project specifications identify work to be performed in the rehabilitation of the filter to include emptying the filter, replacing damaged piping, installing new filter media.

Due to limited availability of information on past work performed, Coastland performed additional services to research the history of this filter and prepare engineered project specifications for the filter rehabilitation.

On July 1, 2020, the District received two (2) bid proposals with an apparent low bid from Euro Style Management (Euro Style) of \$46,900.00. ERS Industrial Services, Inc. (ERS) provided a bid proposal of \$54,640.00. The bids were opened publicly at the appointed time and location. The bid summary sheet as recorded at the public bid opening is attached as **Attachment 2.** The bids from Euro Style and ERS are provided as **Attachments 3 and 4.**

Euro Style Management's bid proposal included all the required forms and staff verified that they have a valid Contractor's license as required by the Project specifications. However, after reviewing the experience and projects submitted by Euro Style, it was apparent that their experience did NOT met the qualifications required by the contract documents, which require a minimum of five years' experience in the rehabilitation, repair, and maintenance of pressure filters (in Section 6-1.08 Workmanship). None of the listed experience in the submitted bid is for pressure filter work. Coastland notified Euro Style of the concern and requested additional information and project references to give them an

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opportunity to demonstrate the required experience. Euro Style sent an email (Attachment 5) with two more project references for similar work on incomplete projects, and information about their material supplier, Envirotrol. Only one of the additional references was for similar pressure filter tank work. Coastland contacted both of the follow up references, and both references were satisfied with the work performed by Euro Style, but Euro Style still does not have the level of specific water pressure tank experience that is required in the specification.

Staff sought direction from the District's attorney, who provided the following response:

"Euro Style's bid would be considered nonresponsive under California law, which requires strict compliance with the material terms of the specifications stated in the request for bids. Although the District can waive strict compliance with some terms stated in a bid solicitation, it can only waive compliance with terms that are "immaterial."

In this case, the experience requirement would be considered a "material" term as it speaks directly to the qualifications needed to perform this work and the quality expected. If the District waived this experience requirement for Euro Style, it would be providing a benefit to Euro Style, who does not have the requisite experience, over ERS, who does have that experience. Accepting Euro Style's bid would thus give Euro Style a competitive advantage and also create the appearance of favoritism, as District would appear willing to waive an experience requirement for the low bidder that it would not need to waive for the second-lowest bidder, ERS. Should ERS pursue a bid protest on these grounds, it would likely prevail. For the same reasons, Euro Style likely would not prevail in a bid protest action if the District awards the contract to ERS."

ERS's bid proposal included all the required forms, and Staff verified that they have a valid Contractor's license as required by the Project specifications. ERS also meets and exceeds the experience requirements listed in the specifications. As such, ERS is the only responsive, responsible bidder.

The total price bid by ERS exceeds the engineer's estimate by \$12,640, but is within the District's construction budget of \$70,000 for this project.

The project is planned to be completed by October 31, 2020. Staff recommends that the General Manager have "change order" authority in an amount not to exceed 20% of the contract amount. This will eliminate the need to return to the Board of Directors for minor changes to the project allowing for a timely completion of the project. Due to the nature of this type of project, the extents of damage and wear to the filter interior cannot be identified without taking it offline and emptying

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it. It is highly probable that there will be some level of extra work needed in order to repair the filter prior to putting it back into service. This extra work includes repairs to the connections between underdrain laterals and the distribution header, repairs to the bulkhead connections to the tank walls, and other incidental welding and recoating.

Because this work cannot be clearly identified or quantified without taking the filter out of service, emptying it, removing the media, and inspecting the interior, the bids do not include repairs to the filter internal piping connections or the tank itself. The contract documents describe the planned extra work and require the contractor to be prepared to perform extra work on a time and materials basis within the allotted timeframe. The cost of this extra work is expected to add approximately 10% to the contract cost. In addition to the planned extra work, it is recommended that the General Manager have the authority to authorize up to 10% in unexpected construction change orders as is standard for most projects.

Once the board takes action to award the contract, Staff will send the Contractor a Notice of Award, and the Contractor will execute the agreement and supply the required performance bond.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Since the bid results plus the recommended 20% contingency fall within the amount programmed in the CIP, the District can take one of three alternative actions:

- Disqualify Euro Style Management and award to ERS (recommended)
- Waive the specific experience requirement and award to Euro Style Management
- 3. Reject all bids and provide direction for a re-bid.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Adopted Capital Improvement Plan budget for this Project is \$100,000 from Fund 43 – Capital Reserve. Current budget and projected costs are summarized in the table below.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the Board of Directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District (GDPUD) adopt the attached Resolution awarding the construction contract to ERS Industrial Services, Inc, authorizing the General Manager to execute a contract with ERS Industrial Services, Inc. in the amount of \$54,640.00 and authorizing the General Manager to approve change orders not to exceed 20% of the contract amount for a total construction authorization amount of \$65,568.00.

Alternatively the Board may (a) award the other scenario; or (b) reject all bids.





The work for which this proposal is submitted is for construction in conformance with the Special Provisions (including the payment of not less than the prevailing wage rates), the project plans, if any, described below, including any addenda thereto, the contract annexed hereto, and also in conformance with the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District specifications.

The Special Provisions for the Work to be done are dated June 2020, and are entitled:

Walton Lake Water Treatment Plant Filter No. 3 Rehabilitation Project

Bids are to be submitted for the entire work. The amount of the bid for comparison will be the total of all items.

The Bidder shall set forth, for each unit basis item of work, a unit price and a total for the item, and for each lump sum item a total for the item, all in clearly legible figures in the respective spaces provided for that purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Item Total" column shall be the product of the unit price bid and the estimated quantity for the item.

In the case of a discrepancy between the unit price and the total set forth for a unit basis item, the unit price shall prevail, except as provided in (a) or (b), as follows:

- (a) If the amount set forth as a unit price is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, or is the same as the amount as the entry in the item total column, then the amount set forth in the item total column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price;
- (b) (Decimal Errors) If the product of the entered unit price and the estimated quantity is exactly off by a factor of ten, one hundred, etc. or one-tenth, one-hundredth, etc. from the

entered total, the discrepancy will be resolved by mutual resolution between the two parties.

If both the unit price and the item total are unreadable or otherwise unclear, or are omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular. Likewise, if the item total for a lump sum item is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular unless the project being bid has only a single item and a clear, readable total bid is provided.

Symbols such as commas and dollar signs will be ignored and have no mathematical significance in establishing any unit price or item total or lump sums. Written unit prices, item totals and lump sums will be interpreted according to the number of digits and, if applicable, decimal placement. Cents symbols also have no significance in establishing any unit price or item total since all figures are assumed to be expressed in dollars and or decimal fractions of a dollar. Bids on lump sum items shall be item totals only; if any unit price for a lump sum item is included in a bid and it differs from the item total, the item total shall prevail.

The foregoing provisions for the resolution of specific irregularities cannot be so comprehensive as to cover every omission, inconsistency, error or other irregularity which may occur in a bid. Any situation not specifically provided for will be determined in the discretion of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, and that discretion will be exercised in the manner deemed by the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District to best protect the public interest in the prompt and economical completion of the work. The decision of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District respecting the amount of a bid, or the existence or treatment of an irregularity in a bid, shall be final.

If this proposal shall be accepted and the undersigned shall fail to enter into the contract and furnish the bond(s) in the sums required by the State Contract Act, with surety satisfactory to the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, and the insurance certificates within ten (10) days, not including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, after the Bidder has received notice from the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District that the contract has been awarded, the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District may, at its option, determine that the Bidder has abandoned the contract, and thereupon this proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void and the forfeiture of the security accompanying this proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District.

When submitting its bid, the Bidder shall include security in the form of cash; cashier's check made payable to the District; a certified check made payable to the District or a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, made payable to the District. The amount of security shall be 10 percent of the amount bid. Should the Bidder be awarded the contract, but fail to execute the contract, its security shall be forfeited to the District.

The Bidder has familiarized itself with the nature and extents of the Contract Documents, the Work, the site, the locality where the Work is to be performed, the legal requirements (federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations), and the conditions affecting cost,

progress or performance of the Work, and has made such independent investigations as Bidder deems necessary.

The undersigned, as bidder, declares that the only persons or parties interested in this proposal as principals are those named herein; that this proposal is made without collusion with any other person, firm, or corporation; that he has carefully examined the plans therein referred to; and the contractor proposes, and agrees if this proposal is accepted, that they will contract with the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, in the form of the copy of the contract annexed hereto, to provide all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus and other means of construction, and to do all the work and furnish all the materials specified in the contract, in the manner and time therein prescribed, and according to the requirements of the District as therein set forth, and that the contractor will take in full payment therefor the following prices, to wit:



- (a) If the amount set forth as a unit price is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, or is the same as the amount as the entry in the item total column, then the amount set forth in the item total column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price;
- (b) (Decimal Errors) If the product of the entered unit price and the estimated quantity is exactly off by a factor of ten, one hundred, etc. or one-tenth, one-hundredth, etc. from the

entered total, the discrepancy will be resolved by mutual resolution between the two parties.

If both the unit price and the item total are unreadable or otherwise unclear, or are omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular. Likewise, if the item total for a lump sum item is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular unless the project being bid has only a single item and a clear, readable total bid is provided.

Symbols such as commas and dollar signs will be ignored and have no mathematical significance in establishing any unit price or item total or lump sums. Any situation not specifically provided for will be determined in the discretion of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, and that discretion will be exercised in the manner deemed by the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District to best protect the public interest in the prompt and economical completion of the work. The decision of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District respecting the amount of a bid, or the existence or treatment of an irregularity in a bid, shall be final.

If this proposal shall be accepted and the undersigned shall fail to enter into the contract and furnish the bond(s) in the sums required by the State Contract Act, with surety satisfactory to the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District, and the insurance certificates within ten (10) days, not including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, after the Bidder has received notice from the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District that the contract has been awarded, the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District may, at its option, determine that the Bidder has abandoned the contract, and thereupon this proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void and the forfeiture of the security accompanying this proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District.

When submitting its bid, the Bidder shall include security in the form of cash; cashier's check made payable to the District; a certified check made payable to the District or a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, made payable to the District. The amount of security shall be 10 percent of the amount bid. Should the Bidder be awarded the contract, but fail to execute the contract, its security shall be forfeited to the District.

 Q: Are there circumstances where more than 14-days will be allowed for the filter to be taken offline?

A: The District can only commit to 14-days at this time as it depends on water demand at the time. If demand is down, there may be flexibility, but the successful contractor shall be prepared to complete the work and anticipated extra work in the 14-day window.

- Q: Are there any record drawings of the filter?
 A: There are no reliable drawings of Filter #3 (the filter to be rehabilitated). There are drawings of Filter #2, which was installed in 2004. The size and general layout of the filter interior is similar, but materials vary. The Filter #2 drawings are provided as an attachment to Addendum #1 (see addendum #1, Item 4), but the District takes no responsibility for assumptions made by the contractor based on the Filter #2 drawings.
- Q: Is there a concrete floor in the filter?
 A: Yes, there is a concrete floor that the underdrain header is partially imbedded in.
- Q: Do you have any recommendations for media supplier?
 A: No. The supplier/manufacturers listed in the contract documents would likely have that information, but no specific supplier is required as long as the media conforms to the requirements of AWWA B100 "Granular Filter Material", is compliant with NSF/ANSI 61, and is specifically for water treatment applications. Per specification section 6-1.13 A3, the supplier shall provide written certification that the materials supplied are in full compliance with the specifications.
