OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR COST OF SERVICE STUDY AND RATE DESIGN – AUBURN LAKE TRAILS WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM WITH HANSFORD ECONOMIC CONSULTING FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,000

WHEREAS, the District issued a Request for Proposal on April 17, 2018, to select a qualified consultant to perform a Cost of Service Study and Rate Design – Auburn Lake Trails Wastewater Disposal System;

WHEREAS, four bids received on May 4, 2018 were reviewed by District Staff and Finance Committee who determined that Hansford Economic Consultant was the most qualified; and

WHEREAS, the contracted cost is not to exceed \$24,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GEORGETOWN PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT THAT:

- The professional services contract is awarded to Hansford Economic Consulting; and
- The General Manager is authorized to execute a professional services contract with Hansford Economic Consulting in the amount not to exceed \$24,000 for the Cost of Service Study and Rate Design – Auburn Lake Trails Wastewater Disposal System.
