

**ORDINANCE NO. 2005 - 02
OF THE GEORGETOWN DIVIDE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT
REVISING DELINQUENCY RATES
AND RELATED FEES**

Be it enacted by the board of directors of the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District that:

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Divide Public Utility District ("District") currently charges a flat rate of ten percent (10%) on delinquent bills and five percent (5%) per month thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges a Thirty Dollar (\$30.00) fee to immediately reactivate service for a customer; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges an Eleven Dollar (\$11.00) fee to reactivate service for customers at the District's convenience; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges an Eleven Dollar (\$11.00) fee to collect payments due the District in the field; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges a Two Dollar Seventy-Five Cent (\$2.75) fee to reactivate multiple unit dwellings; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges a Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee to customers whose payments are required to be deposited a second time by the District's financial institution; and

WHEREAS, the District currently charges a Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee to customers whose payments are returned "not sufficient funds" by the District's financial institution; and

WHEREAS, the administrative burden to staff is not reflected in the current charges; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the delinquency rates and related fees are reasonable and reflect the cost to GDPUD to administer delinquent accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

1. Any utility bill up to Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) that remains unpaid for more than thirty (30) days after the billing date will be charged a flat fee of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and Ten Percent (10%) per month thereafter of the unpaid balance.

2. Any utility bill in excess of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) that remains unpaid for more than thirty (30) days after the billing date will continue to be charged a delinquency fee of Ten Percent (10%) of the unpaid amount and Ten Percent (10%) per month thereafter of the unpaid balance.

3. The fee to immediately activate a customer's domestic water account will be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

4. The fee to activate a customer's domestic water account at the convenience of the District will be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

5. The fee to collect payment in the field will be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00). This means that if a customer is delinquent and wishes an immediate reactivation, the customer will be required to pay the immediate activation fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and the field collection fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for a total of Sixty-five Dollars along with their delinquent amount.

6. The Multiple Dwelling Unit reactivation fee is eliminated. Each account shall pay the same fees as single dwellings. These fees are Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for immediate reactivation and Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for reactivation at the District's convenience for each account.

7. Customers making payments which are returned "Not Sufficient Funds" shall be charged a fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).


