EMERGENCY WATER CONSERVATION REGULATION

Georgetown Divide Public Utility District is issuing this Press Release in response to the State Water Boards emergency water conservation regulation dated May 24, 2022. The regulation requires all urban water suppliers to implement conservation actions under Level 2 of their Water Shortage Contingency Plans that are intended to reduce demand up to 20 percent. Guidelines outlined below are being implemented by the District to meet Level 2 water conservation efforts:

Potable Water Customers:

- Property address ending in an **odd-number** landscape irrigation is limited to Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday;
- Property address ending in an **even-number** landscape irrigation is limited to Wednesday, Friday and Sunday;
- Landscape irrigation is prohibited on Monday;
- Wasting water is not allowed; including water running off properties onto sidewalks or gutters, leaks or breaks not being repaired in a timely manner and ponding of water;
- Hose shutoff nozzles are required;
- Swimming pools or spas are required to be covered;
- Decorative water features are prohibited; and
- Restaurants may only serve water upon request.

Irrigation Customers:

- Irrigation season will be ending September 1, 2022.
